#### Re: Notice of Hearing for Cost Awards Reporting and Record-keeping Requirements Consultation Ontario Energy Board File Number: EB-2022-0267

The Ontario Energy Board (OEB) is giving notice that eligible participants are invited to submit cost claims for eligible activities in relation to the Reporting and Record-keeping Requirements (RRR) Consultation (EB-2022-0267).

## **Background**

On November 14, 2023, the OEB issued a <u>letter</u> to launch a consultation to engage stakeholders on the RRR for Ontario's licensed electricity distributors. This consultation sought feedback from stakeholders on OEB staff's proposed RRR improvements and was a forum to discuss other potential changes to RRR that could help reduce regulatory burden. Feedback was received through a survey on the <u>RRR Consultation</u> <u>Engage With Us page</u> and through a virtual meeting held for interested stakeholders on January 29, 2024. The letter indicated that cost awards would be available under section 30 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998*, and that costs would be recovered from all licensed rate-regulated electricity distributors.

The OEB issued a <u>Decision on Cost Eligibility</u> on January 25, 2024 that determined the following parties were eligible for cost awards:

- Association of Major Power Consumers in Ontario
- Pollution Probe
- School Energy Coalition
- Consumers Council of Canada
- Building Owners and Managers Association
- Environmental Defence

The letter advised that cost awards would be available in relation to participation in the stakeholder meeting plus time for preparation and reporting and requested that groups representing the same interests or class of persons make every effort to communicate and coordinate their participation in the process. The maximum numbers of hours and eligible activities are outlined below.

#### **Eligible Activities**

The eligible activities are as follows:

1	Meeting Preparation and Reporting	1.5
2	Attendance and participation in the January 29, 2024 Virtual Meeting	2

#### Notice of Hearing

The OEB is initiating a hearing on its own motion to determine the cost awards to eligible participants in the RRR Consultation activities. The decision on costs will be made by delegated authority under section 6 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998*.

The hearing will follow the process set out below.

- 1. Eligible participants shall submit their cost claims by **February 23, 2024**. The cost claim must be filed with the OEB and must be completed in accordance with section 10 of the OEB's Practice Direction on Cost Awards. Any cost claims will be available for review by licensed electricity distributors through the OEB's website under file number EB-2022-0267.
- Licensed electricity distributors will have until March 1, 2024 to object to any aspect of the costs claimed. The objection must be filed with the OEB and one copy must be served on the eligible participant against whose claim the objection is being made.
- 3. The eligible participant whose cost claim was objected to will have until **March 8**, **2024** to file its reply submission, if any, with the OEB, with a copy of the reply submission to be served on the objecting party.
- 4. The OEB will then issue its decision on cost awards.

The OEB will use the process set out in section 12 of the Practice Direction to implement the payment of the cost awards. The OEB will therefore act as a clearing house for all payments of cost awards in this process.

## How to File Materials

Stakeholders are responsible for ensuring that any documents they file with the OEB **do not include personal information** (as that phrase is defined in the *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act*), unless filed in accordance with rule 9A of the OEB's <u>Rules of Practice and Procedure</u>.

Please quote file number **EB-2022-0267** for all materials filed and submit them in searchable/unrestricted PDF format with a digital signature through the <u>OEB's online</u> filing portal.

- Filings should clearly state the sender's name, postal address, telephone number and e-mail address.
- Please use the document naming conventions and document submission standards outlined in the <u>Regulatory Electronic Submission System (RESS)</u> <u>Document Guidelines</u> found at the <u>File documents online page</u> on the OEB's website.
- Stakeholders are encouraged to use RESS. Those who have not yet <u>set up an</u> <u>account</u> or require assistance using the online filing portal can contact <u>registrar@oeb.ca</u> for assistance.
- Cost claims are filed through the OEB's online filing portal. Please visit the <u>File</u> <u>documents online page</u> of the OEB's website for more information. All participants shall download a copy of their submitted cost claim and serve it on all required parties as per the <u>Practice Direction on Cost Awards</u>.
