As requested, PowerStream offers the following information relating to the Winter Warmth Program.

#### Financial Commitment

In 2008, PowerStream donated \$30,000 to the Winter Warmth Program. This was PowerStream's first year participating in the program. PowerStream has budgeted \$30,000 for the 2009 fiscal year.

#### Number of Applicants

During the past heating season, 90 households received Winter Warmth Assistance for their electricity account.

## Average Payment Per Household

The average disbursement this past heating season was \$283.33.

### Demand for Winter Warmth Funds

During the past year \$25,500 was distributed to PowerStream customers. The United Way retained 15% of the initial donation, or \$4,500, to cover their program administrative costs. As of April 30<sup>th</sup>, there were no funds remaining.
