### NOTICE OF APPLICATION AND HEARING FOR AN ELECTRICITY DISTRIBUTION RATE CHANGE Lakefront Utilities Inc.

Lakefront Utilities Inc. has filed an application with the Ontario Energy Board, received on November 3, 2007, under section 78 of the Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998, S.O. 1998, c. 15 (Schedule B), seeking approval for changes to the rates that Lakefront Utilities Inc. charges for electricity distribution, to be effective May 1, 2008. The Board has assigned the application file number EB-2007-0761. The Board's decision on this application may have an effect on all of Lakefront Utilities Inc.'s customers.

Any change to Lakefront Utilities Inc.'s distribution rates will cause Lakefront Utilities Inc.'s delivery charges to change. Delivery charges are one of four regular items on residential and general service customers' electric bills and vary depending on the amount of electricity consumed.

Lakefront Utilities Inc. is seeking approval of \$4,742,279 as the annual revenue it requires to provide electricity distribution. Lakefront Utilities Inc. indicates that if the application is approved as filed, a residential customer consuming 1,000 kWh per month would experience an approximate 4.6% increase in the electricity bill. A small general service customer consuming 3,000 kWh per month and having a monthly demand of 50 kW or lower would see an approximate 5.3% increase in the electricity bill.

The major items addressed by this application include: distribution costs; distribution revenues; final recovery of costs associated with market opening and certain other deferred costs; demand forecasts; forecasted capital expenditures and changes in retail transmission rates.

#### How to Participate

You may participate in this proceeding in one of three ways:

##### 1. Send a Letter with your Comments to the Board

Your letter with comments will be provided to the Board members deciding the application, and will be part of the public record for the application. Your letter must be received by the Board no later than **30 days** from the publication or service date of this notice. The Board accepts letters of comment by either post or e-mail at the addresses below.

##### 2. Become an Observer

Observers do not actively participate in the proceeding but monitor the progress of the proceeding by receiving documents issued by the Board. You may request observer status in order to receive documents issued by the Board in this proceeding. If you become an observer, you need to contact the applicant and others in order to receive documents that they file in this proceeding and they may charge you for this. Most documents filed in this application will also be available on the Board's website. Your request for observer status must be made in writing and be received by the Board no later than **10 days** from the publication or service date of this notice. The Board accepts observer request letters by either post or e-mail at the addresses below; however, two paper copies are also required. You must also provide a copy of your letter to the applicant.

##### 3. Become an Intervenor

You may ask to become an intervenor if you wish to actively participate in the proceeding. Intervenor status is eligible to receive evidence and other material submitted by participants in the hearing. Likewise, intervenors will be expected to send copies of any material they file to all parties to the hearing. Your request for intervenor status must be made by letter of intervention and be received by the Board no later than **10 days** from the publication or service date of this notice. Your letter of intervention must include a description of how you are, or may be, affected by the outcome of this proceeding; and if you represent a group, a description of the group and its membership. The Board may order costs in this proceeding. You must indicate in your letter of intervention whether you expect to seek costs from the applicant and the grounds for your eligibility for costs. You must provide a copy of your letter of intervention to the applicant.

The Board intends to proceed with this application by way of written hearing. The Board will not hold a written hearing if a party satisfies the Board that there is good reason for holding an oral hearing. If you object to the Board holding a written hearing, your letter of intervention must include reasons why an oral hearing is necessary.
