Any change to Lakefront Utilities Inc.'s distribution rates will cause Lakefront Utilities Inc.'s delivery charges to change. Delivery charges are one of four regular items on residential and general service customers. to change. Delivery charges are one of four regular items on residential electric bills and vary depending on the amount of electricity consumed.

Lakefront Utilities Inc. is seeking approval of \$4,742,279 as the annual revenue it requires to provide electricity distribution. Lakefront Utilities Inc. indicates that if the application is approved as filed, a residential customer consuming 1,000 kWh per month would experience an approximate 4.6% increase in the electricity bill. A small general service customer consuming 3,000 kWh per month and having a monthly demand of 50 kW or lower would see an approximate 5.3% increase in the electricity bill.

The major items addressed by this application include: distribution costs; distribution revenues; final recovery of costs associated with market opening and certain other deferred costs; demand forecasts, forecasted capital expenditures and changes in retail transmission rates.
