# NOTICE OF APPLICATION AND HEARING FOR AN **ELECTRICITY DISTRIBUTION RATE CHANGE**

# Newmarket - Tay Power Distribution Limited **Newmarket Service Area**

Newmarket – Tay Power Distribution Ltd. has filed an application with the Ontario Energy Board, received on July 4, 2008, under section 78 of the Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998, S.O. 1998, c. 15 (Schedule B), seeking approval for changes to the rates that Newmarket – Tay Power Distribution Ltd. charges for electricity distribution, within its Newmarket Service Area, to be effective from the date of the Board's Decision. The Board has assigned the application file number E8-2007-0776. The Board's decision on this application may have an effect on all of Newmarket – Tay Power Distribution Ltd. customers within the Newmarket Service Area.

Any change to Newmarket - Tay Power Distribution Ltd.'s distribution rates will cause Newmarket - Tay Power Distribution Ltd.'s delivery charges to change. Delivery charges are one of four regular items on residential and general service customers' electric bills and vary depending on the amount of electricity consumed.

Newmarket – Tay Power Distribution Ltd. is seeking approval of \$15,190.270 as the annual revenue it requires to provide electricity distribution within its Newmarket Service Area. Newmarket – Tay Power Distribution Ltd. indicates that if the application is approved as filed, a residential customer consuming 1,000 kWh per month would experience an approximate 1.8% decrease in the total electricity bill. A general service customer having a monthly demand of 50 kW or lower and consuming 3,000 kWh per month (the approximate class average consumption) would see an approximate 1.3% decrease in the total electricity bill relating to Street Lighting will be an approximate increase of 19%.

Newmarket - Tay Power Distribution Ltd. also requests that the Board issue an interim approval to immediately implement its proposed Retail Transmission - Network Service and Retail Transmission - Line Connection and Transformation Connection Service Rates.

The major items addressed by this application include the recovery of costs associated with: Smart Meters and Time-of-Use Rate implementation; the Holland Junction TS investment; and increases in Rate Base and operating expenses that reflect historical customer and load growth rates of 20.6% and 23.4% respectively during the nine-year period beginning in 1999.

Your letter with comments will be provided to the Board members deciding the application, and will be part of the public record for the application. Your letter must be received by the Board no later than 30 days from the publication or service date of this notice. The Board accepts letters of comment by either post or e-mail at the addresses below.

Observers do not actively participate in the proceeding but monitor the progress of the proceeding by receiving documents issued by the Board.

You may request observer status in order to receive documents issued by the Board in this proceeding. If you become an observer, you need to contact the applicant and others in order to receive documents that they file in this proceeding and they may charge you for this. Most documents filed in this application will also be available on the Board's website. Your request for observer status must be made in writing and be received by the Board no later than 10 days from the publication or service date of this notice. The Board accepts observer request letters by either post or e-mail at the addresses below; however, two paper copies are also required. You must also provide a copy of your letter to the applicant.

# 3. Become an Interveno

You may ask to become an intervenor if you wish to actively participate in the proceeding. Intervenors are eligible to receive evidence and other material submitted by participants in the hearing. Likewise, intervenors will be expected to send copies of any material they file to all parties to the

Your request for intervenor status must be made by letter of intervention and be received by the Board no later than 10 days from the publication or service date of this notice. Your letter of intervention must include a description of how you are, or may be, affected by the outcome of this proceeding; and if you represent a group, a description of the group and its membership.

The Board may choose to hold either a written or an oral hearing. Your letter of intervention should indicate your preference for a written or oral hearing, and the reasons for that preference. The Board will not hold a written hearing if a party satisfies the Board that there is good reason for holding an oral hearing. The Board may order costs in this proceeding. You must indicate in your letter of intervention whether you expect to seek costs from the applicant and the grounds for your eligibility for costs. You must provide a copy of your letter of intervention to the applicant.
