We are counsel to the Council.


We have been instructed by our client to intervene in the above-captioned application of Enwin Utilities Ltd. seeking approval for changes to its distribution rates. The Council is a non-profit, public interest entity, representing the interests of residential consumers of electricity in Ontario, including ratepayers in Enwin's distribution area. The application, if approved, would result in an increase in Enwin's delivery charge of 9.7% for a typical residential consumer.
