OEB Proceedings:

The Council has been participating in many applications over the past 24 months as an intervenor.

Issues:

The Consumers Council of Canada is materially impacted by the application as it represents residential consumers of electricity. Our interest at this point is in all aspects of the Application. The changes to the Hydroelectric Surplus Baseload Generation Variance Account and the Hydroelectric Incentive Mechanism can impact the ultimate bills of Ontario electricity ratepayers. In addition, the over deferral and variance account balances ultimately impact ratepayers.
