### **EAST WINDSOR (EXPANSION) L.P.**

#### **Application for an Electricity Generation Licence**

## DECISION AND ORDER

East Windsor (Expansion) L.P. (East Windsor Expansion) filed an application with the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) on December 6, 2023, under section 60 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998* (OEB Act) for an electricity generation licence.

This Decision and Order is being issued by the Delegated Authority, pursuant to Section 6 of the OEB Act. The Delegated Authority has considered the application without holding a hearing pursuant to section 6(4) of the OEB Act.

East Windsor Expansion was formed to participate in the Independent Electricity System Operator's (IESO) Expedited Long-Term RFP, E-LT1 RFP. The applicant's proposal was selected by the IESO and a formal agreement, between both parties, was ratified to formalize the long-term contractual arrangements to generate electricity.

The applicant has stated that it will own and operate one natural gas generation facility located in Windsor, Ontario. The applicant also stated that it expects to commence construction of the facility in July 2024 and commercial operation on August 31, 2025.

After considering the application and assessing the technical capability and financial viability of the applicant, the OEB finds that it is in the public interest to grant the application and issue an electricity generation licence to East Windsor Expansion. However, as the applicant has not yet constructed the facility and considering that it does not expect to commence commercial operation until August 31, 2025, the OEB's approval in this Decision and Order shall not take effect until the applicant files written evidence with the OEB confirming completion of construction of the facility and ready to commence commercial operation. Once the OEB receives the written confirmation a generation licence will be issued to East Windsor Expansion L.P.

### IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. Subject to paragraph 2 below, the application by East Windsor (Expansion) L.P. for an electricity generation licence is approved.

2. The grant of the electricity generation licence shall not take effect until East Windsor (Expansion) L.P. advises the OEB, in writing, that the facility described in its application, and summarized in the Decision and Order, has been constructed and is ready to commence commercial operation.
