**RE: Application to Extend Third Tranche CDM Funding Beyond September 30, 2007**

Enclosed please find a submission from West Perth Power Inc. requesting an extension of the time over which the previously approved conservation and demand management third tranche budget is spent. The initial CDM Plans were submitted and approved as application **File No. RP-2004-0203/EB-2004-0548**.

The details of the request from West Perth Power are enclosed. The submission requests:

- An extension to December 31, 2008
- Revision of expenditures and
- That the Ontario Energy Board dispose of the proceeding without a hearing pursuant to subsection 21(4)(b) of the Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998.

The change in distribution of the funds will allow West Perth Power Inc. to further assist the Government of Ontario in creating a conservation culture. West Perth Power Inc. will deliver a seasonal LED light exchange, a seasonal conservation program and tips newsletter and provide incentive to the municipality to replace the old incandescent seasonal decorations with new energy efficient LED seasonal decorations. Through the delivery of the programs West Perth Power Inc. will:

- Develop local partnerships for delivering future conservation initiatives;
- Educate customers on energy conservation products and actions;
