The Ontario Energy Board (OEB) received uTrack's application for an unit sub-metering licence on March 18, 2024. The OEB has assigned file number EB-2024-0122 to the application.

The applicant states that its "application is for a transfer of licence from the parent company, Edgecom Energy and is already providing these services."

If no, Edgecom Energy is required to submit a request to cancel its unit submetering licence (ES-2020-0099) to the Office of the Registrar and include a reason for the cancellation.
