Further to the question submitted by Ontario Energy Board Staff related to the requested certificate of public convenience and necessity (CPCN), Enbridge Gas provides the following response.

Reference: EB-2024-0101, Application and Evidence, page 3

Preamble:

While Enbridge Gas has noted it holds franchise agreements and certificates with the Township of Blandford-Blenheim, the County of Brant, Norfolk County, the Township of South-West Oxford, the Town of Tillsonburg, and the City of Woodstock, all immediately adjacent to the municipality, Enbridge Gas also noted that the nearest natural gas distributor is EPCOR Natural Gas.

Question:

a) Please confirm that the request does not affect EPCOR Natural Gas's certificate rights?

Response:

a) Confirmed. While EPCOR Natural Gas holds limited CPCN-related rights within Norfolk County and the Township of South-West Oxford (which are not impacted by this application), Enbridge Gas is not aware of EPCOR holding any CPCN rights within the Township of Norwich or other municipalities adjacent to the Township of Norwich that would be impacted by the application.
