**Re: Lagasco Inc.
Application for a Limited Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity
Haldimand County
Ontario Energy Board File No. EB-2023-0344**

In accordance with the April 16, 2024 letter from the Ontario Energy Board, attached is a copy of an email received from Proplant Propagation Services confirming its commitment to pursue receiving service from Enbridge Gas for its proposed electricity generation facility.

With respect to Lagasco's comments in its April 11, 2024 submission regarding "*last-minute secret market-offer interference from an Ontario regulated utility*", "*it seems wrong that EGI is able to wait in the weeds for years and months to eviscerate a competitive response to Proplant in this manner*" and "*deliberate injection of adjusted and possibly manipulated information*", Enbridge Gas submits that all discussions with potential customers are always treated confidentially to protect the commercial interests of both parties. Enbridge Gas has been working with Proplant representatives for several months, at their request, to gain a more complete understanding of their service needs and how best to serve these needs.

It wasn't until March 2024 that Proplant confirmed the level of firm service (m³/hour) that it would require for its existing service and the proposed electricity generation facility, and the updated load request was approximately 60% less than the original request. Enbridge Gas used this information to develop the updated service proposal that formed the basis of the evidence submitted on April 5, 2024. Lagasco's accusations about the actions of Enbridge Gas are completely unfounded and misguided. Enbridge Gas acted in accordance with requests and instructions from Proplant.

Enbridge Gas will pursue finalization of contract arrangements with Proplant after May 6, 2024, which is the date that the Ontario Energy Board has set for Lagasco to withdraw its application.
