This letter is in response to the Independent Electricity System Operator's (IESO) request for late intervenor status in the above-referenced proceeding. The Ontario Energy Board (OEB) received the IESO's intervention request on January 17, 2024, after the close of the intervention period.

The IESO states it works at the heart of Ontario's power system by directing the flow of electricity across the province's transmission lines and administering Ontario's electricity markets. The IESO monitors supply and demand in real-time ensuring that enough energy is available when and where it is needed. The IESO also works with communities and stakeholders to forecast energy demand and plan changes to the system that ensure electricity remains affordable, reliable and sustainable.

Toronto Hydro did not object to the IESO's request.

The IESO shall accept the record of the proceeding as it stands to this point and should refer to the OEB's Procedural Order No.1, dated January 15, 2024, for the schedule. The IESO is not eligible to apply for cost awards.
