Re: Electric Vehicle Integration (EVI) Initiative (EB-2023-0071) Electricity Delivery Rates for Electric Vehicle (EV) Charging Invitation to Stakeholder Meeting

The Ontario Energy Board (OEB) invites stakeholders to a meeting on June 13, 2024, to discuss a proposal for an electricity delivery rate for public EV charging stations that have a low load factor, which aims to further facilitate the integration of EV chargers with the electricity system.

Background on the Proposed Rate

The OEB commissioned a consultant, Power Advisory, to analyze the impact delivery costs have on EV charging and explore alternative delivery rate designs to support EV adoption while adhering to sound ratemaking principles. Power Advisory's report, <u>Electricity Delivery Rates for EV Charging</u>, was released on April 13, 2023. The OEB held a stakeholder meeting on May 24, 2023, to get feedback on the report and also sought written feedback from stakeholders afterward.

Based on stakeholder feedback, and additional analysis conducted by its consultant, OEB staff has developed a proposal for an EV charging rate that improves cost causality and better supports the efficient integration of EVs in Ontario.

Invitation to Participate in Stakeholder Meeting

The OEB is inviting interested stakeholders to a virtual meeting on **June 13, 2024,** from **9:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m.** to discuss the proposal and gather feedback on it.

The OEB recognizes this topic is of interest to many parties, and therefore welcomes feedback from a broad cross-section of industry stakeholders, regardless of their

involvement with EVs. Stakeholders will also be invited to provide written feedback after the stakeholder meeting.

Materials will be shared prior to the meeting on the OEB's Engage with Us <u>EVI</u> webpage, and recipients of this letter will be notified.

Cost Award Matters

Cost awards will be available to eligible participants under section 30 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998* for participation in the consultation. Costs awarded will be recovered from all licensed rate-regulated electricity distributors. Further information regarding cost awards is included in Appendix A to this letter. Participants eligible for cost awards in the EVI initiative (EB-2023-0071) remain eligible.

Appendix A

Cost Award Matters

Cost Award Eligibility

The OEB will determine eligibility for costs in accordance with its <u>Practice Direction on</u> <u>Cost Awards</u>. Any person intending to request an award of costs, except for those participants previously found to be eligible for costs for EB-2023-0071, must file with the OEB a written submission to that effect by **May 22, 2024**. The submission must identify the grounds on which the person believes that it is eligible for an award of costs (addressing the OEB's cost eligibility criteria as set out in section 3 of the *Practice Direction on Cost Awards*). An explanation of any other funding to which the person has access must also be provided, as should the name and credentials of any lawyer, analyst or consultant that the person intends to retain, if known. All requests for cost eligibility will be posted on the OEB's website. If a licensed rate-regulated electricity distributor has any objections to any of the requests for cost eligibility, such objections must be filed with the OEB by **May 29, 2024.** Any objections will be posted on the OEB's website. The OEB will then make a final determination on the cost eligibility of the requesting participants.

In accordance with section 12 of its *Practice Direction on Cost Awards*, the OEB will act as a clearing house for all payments of cost awards in this process.
