INTERIM DECISION AND ORDER

Intellimeter Canada Inc. (Intellimeter) submitted a request to the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) on April 23, 2024, for an interim extension to its unit sub-metering licence ES-2019-0017, to avoid non-compliance with section 57 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998* (OEB Act).

Intellimeter's unit sub-metering licence ES-2019-0017 is set to expire on May 15, 2024. In order for the applicant to continue providing unit sub-metering services in Ontario, the applicant requires a unit sub-metering licence pursuant to section 57 of the OEB Act.

Intellimeter became aware of the licence expiry after OEB staff contacted it regarding the upcoming licence expiry. Intellimeter immediately submitted a request to extend the licence term of its unit sub-metering licence and took steps to begin the unit sub-metering licence renewal application process, in accordance with section 60 of the OEB Act. Intellimeter in its request asked that the term of its unit sub-metering licence be extended so that it may continue to operate while its licence application is filed and considered by the OEB.

Considering the time required to process an application in accordance with the OEB's established practice and procedures, and considering the applicant's need for a licence to carry out activities as a unit sub-metering provider, the OEB finds it expedient to extend the term of the existing licence, pending the final disposition of the matter. This Decision and Order does not constitute a final decision on the application.

The applicant is reminded that it carries the onus of filing an application in a timely manner considering the OEB's typical timelines for processing licence applications.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The term of Intellimeter Canada Inc.'s unit sub-metering licence ES-2019-0017 is extended on an interim basis until October 1, 2024, or until the final determination of the unit sub-metering licence application, whichever is earlier. The conditions of licence remain unchanged.
