IN THE MATTER OF the *Ontario Energy Board Act 1998*, S.O.1998, c.15, (Schedule B);

AND IN THE MATTER OF an Application by Union Gas Limited for an Order pursuant to Section 36 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998,* seeking changes to reduce its financial exposure in regard to a Bundled T Gas Contract and an M9 Delivery Contract with Natural Resource Gas Limited.

PROCEDURAL ORDER NO. 1

Union Gas Limited ("Union") has filed an application with the Ontario Energy Board (the "Board") on August 1, 2008, as amended on October 9, 2008 and as further amended on October 15, 2008 pursuant to section 36 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act* 1998, S.O. 1998, c.15. The Board has assigned the application file number EB-2008-0273.

Natural Resource Gas Limited ("NRG") delivers gas to Union under a Bundled T Gas Contract first made as of October 2004. Union re-delivers gas, as a gas transmitter, to NRG pursuant to an M9 Delivery Contract first made as of October 2006.

Union has sought certain financial assurances from NRG under the terms of a contract between the parties. In Union's view, NRG has failed to provide the requested assurances and Union considers this to be a breach of the contract between the parties.

On October 15, 2008, the Board held an oral hearing for the Issues Day. The Transcript for that hearing contains the Board's findings and decisions in regard to the approved Issues List, the determination that the Board will consider Union's application under section 36 of the Act, and that the Oral hearing will commence on **Monday**, **October 20, 2008** and if needed would continue on **Tuesday**, **October 21, 2008**. The Board also requested that NRG make available its financial auditors (Neal, Pallet & Townsend

LLP) for the hearing. The Board approved Issues List is attached as Appendix A to this Order. The list of Intervenors who shall receive this order is attached as Appendix B.

Appendix A

Issues List

- 1. Does Union have reasonable grounds to believe that NRG's credit worthiness under the prior contract has become unsatisfactory?
- 2. Was the amount of the financial assurance requested by Union determined in a commercially reasonable manner?
- 3. Can the need for financial assurances be avoided by restructuring of NRG's bundled T conditions of service to provide for a March 31 year end and a DCQ which targets a March 31 balance of zero (+/- 4%)?
- 4. Should the Board issue an order imposing conditions of service on NRG which provide for transition to a March 31 year end and an adjustment to NRG's DCQ which targets a March 31 balance of zero (+/- 4%)?
- 5. Alternatively, should the Board issue an order requiring NRG, as a condition of Union's continued service, to provide the financial assurance Union has requested?
- 6. What are the rate impacts (to NRG's customers) associated with issues 4 and 5 above?
- 7. Are there other alternatives (other than moving to an April 1 contract start date) that would avoid the need for financial assurance?
