I feel the rolling 6 month average of the TSX Oil and Gas EW Index (<https://www.theglobeandmail.com/investing/markets/indices/TXOE/>) should be used to set prices every 6 months. Delivery charges should be absorbed by the utility, not paid by the consumer. If the utilities do not like that, then open up the market to more competition. Lastly, the amount of carbon generated when each fuel is burned should be ranked, the fuel the generates the most carbon should be taxed the highest, with those dollars sent directly to people who consume a fuel that is cleaner (ie. gasoline tax is increased and that money offsets the cost the consumer pays for burning cleaner fuels like natural gas).
