Re: Hydro One Remote Communities Inc. – EG-2023-0227 Generation Licence Amendment

Hydro One Remote Communities Inc. ("Remotes") hereby applies for an amendment to its electricity generation licence under Section 74 of the Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998 (OEB Act) to update the ownership details for the Deer Lake Hydel generator station, which changed on April 16, 2024. The change in ownership resulted from the Wataynikaneyap Power Limited Partnership (WPLP) grid connection and Remotes is now only an operator of the generation station. Remotes also requests that the generation station name be updated to Deer Lake/Shoulderblade Falls Hydel Generation Station.

Following discussions with Board staff regarding the need for the generation licence amendment, Remotes is providing the following detailed information.

Amendments to Schedule 1 of Electricity Generation Licences:

- Name and address of generation facility:
 Deer Lake/Shoulderblade Falls Hydel Generation Station at Deer Lake, Ontario
- Size, fuel type, and number of units:
 0.49 MW, Water, 2 units
- Name of the owner and operator:
 - The owner is Deer Lake First Nation and the operator is Remotes.
- Relevant financial information related to the amendment, (e.g., capital cost of the project(s), brief
 description of financing arrangements, date that generator is expected to be operational):

 The generation station has been operational for ever 25 years, and the related capital cost is
 - The generation station has been operational for over 25 years, and the related capital cost is expected to be minimal.
- Whether or not the facility is under a Feed-in Tariff contract or any other power purchase agreements with the Independent Electricity System Operator:
 - The facility currently has no power purchase agreement with the IESO.



Remotes requests that this application proceed without a hearing as allowed under section 21(4)(b) of the OEB Act, as no person will be adversely affected in a material way by the approval of this application.
