The Ontario Energy Board (OEB) received Enercan's application for a unit sub-metering licence on June 19, 2024. The OEB has assigned file number EB-2024-0215 to the application.

Upon preliminary review of the application, OEB staff has determined it to be incomplete. Accordingly, please be advised that the application cannot be processed until the following missing information is filed:

1. Section 9(a): Corporate Organization:

Please submit a corporate organization chart that outlines the applicant, its parent, and any associated affiliates of the applicant.

2. Section 11: Technical Resources

The applicant states that it contracts Hydro Connection Inc. to provide unit sub-metering technical support.

As per the OEB's [Unit Sub-Metering Code](#), "metering services" is defined as installation, testing, reading, and maintenance of meters.

Please identify the technical support services that Hydro Connection Inc. provides for the applicant.

Please note, section 57(c.1) of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998* (OEB Act) states that no person is permitted to engage in unit sub-metering without a licence. According to OEB records, the unit sub-metering licence ES-2018-0212 assigned to Hydro Connection Inc. expired on October 17, 2023.

Hydro Connection Inc. which is in non-compliance with Section 57 (c.1) of the OEB Act, is performing (as per Enercan's licence application) unit sub-metering technical support without a valid OEB Licence. OEB Staff has contacted Hydro Connection Inc. regarding the non-compliance issue and is awaiting a response.

The OEB will process the application after the noted information is filed with the Registrar at registrar@oeb.ca. Please submit both an electronic Word version and an electronically signed, searchable PDF. If the above information is not filed within 30 days of the date of this letter, the OEB may close the file for this application.

Please note, Enercan is responsible for ensuring that the documents it files with the OEB, such as its evidence, responses to interrogatories and any other supporting documentation, do not include personal information (as that phrase is defined in the *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act*), unless filed in accordance with rule 9A of the OEB's *Rules of Practice and Procedure*.
