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Good morning.

Enbridge would like to participate in this consultation with myself as a working group representative for both Stream 1 and Stream 2.

Sector changes and new demands are important considerations for any review of cost allocation and recovery policies. There could also be consideration for a standardized connection agreement for energy storage and consideration of a minimum review frequency.

Enbridge also considers that there are important related technical developments and opportunities to improve the quality of the grid and the balancing of stakeholder interests and that some of these should be considered as part of cost allocation discussions.

The issuance by FERC of Order 1920 could include some important considerations leading to the improvement of Ontario's transmission system and improving the connection process and capacity allocation to new generation projects including substantial deployments of renewables and energy storage as part of the broader electrification across the province.
