**EB-2022-0335 Enbridge IRP Pilot
Pollution Probe Technical Conference Estimate**

Dear Ms. Marconi:

In accordance with OEB direction, Pollution Probe estimates 120 minutes for the Technical Conference. The areas of focus are the Updated Interrogatories and Updated Evidence related to the Issues 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5. Pollution Probe also requests that the Technical Conference commence with a short presentation by Enbridge. This approach has been leveraged in most recent Technical Conferences and has enabled an efficient approach. Inclusion of the following items in the presentation would be helpful.

- Scope of proposed South Lake Huron Pilot including the type, number cost and forecasted impact of participant measures anticipated to be deployed.
- How this pilot was selected as the best option against the all other project options in Enbridge's Capital Plan.
- Partnerships and collaboration agreements in place with IESO, Bluewater Power, the municipality and other relevant stakeholders.
- Forecasted results expected by sector for residential, industrial and commercial within the Pilot area.
- Verification protocols proposed to be used.
