DECISION AND ORDER ON COST AWARDS

OVERVIEW

This Decision and Order provides the OEB's determination on cost awards regarding the Integrated Resource Planning (IRP) Working Group activities from January 1, 2024 to June 30, 2024. The IRP Working Group, led by OEB staff, provides input on IRP issues that will be of value to both Enbridge Gas in implementing IRP, and to the OEB in its oversight of the IRP Framework.

The OEB issued four prior cost award decisions in this proceeding:

- August 23, 2022, Decision and Order on Cost Eligibility and Cost Awards for activities from January 1, 2022, to June 30, 2022
- March 13, 2023, Decision and Order on Cost Awards for activities from July 1, 2022, to December 31, 2022
- September 27, 2023, Decision and Order on Cost Awards for activities from January 1, 2023 to June 30, 2023
- April 11, 2024, Decision and Order on Cost Awards for activities from July 1, 2023 to December 31, 2023

On July 18, 2024, the OEB issued its Notice of Hearing for Cost Awards (Notice). The Notice stated that cost awards would be available for eligible participants under Section 30 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998* and that costs awarded would be recovered from all rate-regulated natural gas distributors based on their respective distribution revenues.

Cost-eligible participants were allowed to claim the activities up to the prescribed maximum hours listed in Appendix A of the Notice.

The OEB received cost claims from DNV Energy Insights USA, Inc. (DNV Energy), DR Quinn & Associates Ltd. (DR Quinn), Energy Futures Group, ICF Consulting Canada Inc. (ICF) and Shepherd Rubenstein Professional Corporation (Shepherd Rubenstein). No objections to the cost claims were received from the natural gas distributors.

Findings

The OEB has reviewed the claims filed to ensure that they are compliant with the *Practice Direction on Cost Awards* (Practice Direction).

For all participants that filed cost claims, the OEB has previously determined that these participants meet the criteria set out in the OEB's Practice Direction and are therefore eligible for cost awards (eligible participants). The OEB finds that the cost claims are reasonable and within the maximum number of hours eligible for cost awards. The OEB approves cost awards for the eligible participants as follows:

• DNV Energy	\$6,525.75
• DR Quinn	\$11,187.00
• Energy Futures Group	\$5,445.00
• ICF	\$8,028.65
• Shepherd Rubenstein	\$12,007.38

Process for Paying the Cost Awards

The amount payable by each rate-regulated natural gas distributor in relation to costs awarded to each eligible participant is listed in Schedule A to this Decision and Order. However, the amounts will not be paid directly by the natural gas distributors to the eligible participants. The OEB will use the process set out in Section 12 of the Practice Direction to implement the payment of the approved cost awards whereby the OEB will act as a clearing house for all payments of cost awards. Consistent with this process, each natural gas distributor is issued one invoice that covers all cost awards payable for the relevant period. As a result, the invoice may cover cost awards payable in relation to a number of proceedings and consultations, including this proceeding. The invoice will be sent out at the same time as the invoices for cost assessments under section 26 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998*, are sent out, and payment will be due at the same time that cost assessments are due.

The OEB makes payment to each eligible participant once 80% of the costs have been recovered by the OEB.

THE ONTARIO ENERGY BOARD ORDERS THAT:

1. Each natural gas distributor shall pay the amounts set out in Schedule A upon receipt of an invoice from the OEB that includes those costs. The payment shall be due at the same time as all other cost assessments under section 26 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998*.
