APPrO Letter of Intervention

We are legal counsel to the Association of Power Producers of Ontario ("APPrO"). We are writing on behalf of APPrO to request intervenor status in the application of Enbridge Gas Distribution Inc. for the approval or fixing of rates for the distribution, transmission and storage of natural gas beginning January 1, 2009 (EB-2008-0219).

APPrO is a non-profit organization representing more than 100 companies involved in the generation of electricity in Ontario, including generators and suppliers of services, equipment and consulting services. APPrO members, who currently produce over 95% of electricity made in Ontario, produce power from gas, cogeneration, hydroelectric, coal, nuclear, wind energy, waste wood and other facilities.

A significant portion of Ontario's new electricity supply will come from gas-fired generation and there are a number of existing gas-fired generators operating in Ontario at present. As a result, many of APPrO's members have a direct interest in the outcome of this proceeding. APPrO will be in a position to ensure that the interests of all of its gas-fired generator members are brought forward.

APPrO takes no position on whether the proceeding is conducted by way of oral or written hearing. Similarly, APPrO has no comments on the advisability of the Board proceeding with Enbridge's proposed two-phased approach to the review of its application.

For the purposes of this intervention, APPrO intends to seek a determination by the Board at the conclusion of this proceeding that APPrO is eligible for a cost award. APPrO represents the direct interests of gas-fired generators who are ratepayers in relation to the regulated services provided by Enbridge. APPrO has a record of participating in Board proceedings in a responsible and efficient manner. The Board has previously determined that APPrO has been eligible for cost awards, for example in the NGEIR proceeding and in the combined proceeding for 2008 rates for Enbridge and Union Gas Limited. It is appropriate for the Board to do so again in the context of this proceeding, in light of the issues that this proceeding raises.
