## Re: Enbridge Gas Inc. - Application for the renewal of a Municipal Franchise Agreement with the County of Lennox and Addington OEB File Number: EB-2024-0134

On September 2, 2024, the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) issued Procedural Order No. 2 in the above-referenced proceeding. Among other things, it established the hearing process related to interrogatories, evidence, and submissions.

The OEB has reviewed the recent filings received from Concerned Residents on September 20, 2024, and Enbridge Gas Inc. on September 24, 2024 in this proceeding.

Having considered the submissions made by the parties in these recent filings, the OEB confirms that the procedural steps set out in Procedural Order No. 2 remain unchanged, at this point.

Following the filing of interrogatory responses by Enbridge Gas Inc. on or before September 30, 2024, should Concerned Residents seek to introduce new evidence, it shall, by October 7, 2024, file a detailed outline of its proposed evidence with the OEB.

This outline, for the OEB's consideration, should include a proposed budget and an explanation of how the proposed evidence relates to the County of Lennox and Addington and natural gas customers residing there who would be impacted by the franchise renewal.
