OVERVIEW

On January 12, 2024, the Independent Electricity System Operator (IESO) filed an application with the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) under section 25(1) of the *Electricity Act, 1998*, seeking approval to modify its revenue requirements, expenditures and usage fees for fiscal years 2024-2025.

On August 1, 2024, the OEB issued a Decision and Order in which it set out the process for cost claims. The OEB received cost claims from the Association of Major Power Consumers in Ontario (AMPCO), the Association of Power Producers of Ontario (APPrO), Canadian Manufacturers & Exporters (CME), Energy Probe, Environmental Defence, the School Energy Coalition (SEC), and the Vulnerable Energy Consumers Coalition (VECC).

No objections to the cost claims were received from IESO.

Findings

The OEB has reviewed the claims filed to ensure that they are compliant with the OEB's *Practice Direction on Cost Awards*.

The OEB finds that the cost claims are reasonable and shall be reimbursed by IESO.

THE ONTARIO ENERGY BOARD ORDERS THAT:

1. Pursuant to section 30 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998*, IESO shall immediately pay the following amounts to the intervenors for their costs:

• AMPCO	\$12,305.72
• APPrO	\$4,391.18
• CME	\$10,006.15
• Energy Probe	\$10,719.25
• Environmental Defence	\$3,871.38
• SEC	\$14,680.96
• VECC	\$12,691.07
