Re: EB-2008-0298 - Lennox Reliability Must-Run Agreement

On October 17, 2008 the OEB issued its Notice of Application and Hearing with respect to Ontario Power Generation's (OPG's) request for approval of the Reliability Must-Run (RMR) contract for the Lennox Generating Station. The Procedural Order attached to the Notice stated that the Board wishes to further examine the issue of the continued need for Lennox as a reliability must-run resource beyond September 30, 2009. This letter is in response to that Procedural Order.

OPG agrees that it would be beneficial to address the issue of the continued need for Lennox in this proceeding and the potential for a multi-year arrangement for Lennox. Given the adjournment of the proceeding to consider the Ontario Power Authority's (OPA's) Integrated Power System Plan (IPSP), which identified the ongoing requirement for Lennox in its prefiled evidence, it is in the public interest to consider the most cost effective mechanism to address the system need for Lennox until a decision is reached on the IPSP.

OPG is discussing this issue with the OPA and IESO and will be developing evidence in this regard for submission to the Board.
