**Application for a Unit Sub-Metering Licence**

## Decision and Order

Enercan Energy Management - Division of 373948 Ontario Inc. (Enercan) filed a complete application on July 30, 2024, with the Ontario Energy Board (OEB), under section 60 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998* (OEB Act) to renew a unit sub-metering licence. The licence would allow the applicant to continue providing unit sub-metering services in Ontario.

This Decision and Order is being issued by the Delegated Authority without a hearing pursuant to section 6(4) of the OEB Act.

The applicant was previously licensed by the OEB as a unit sub-meter provider, however its licence expired on February 20, 2024. Enercan acknowledges that it has been providing unit sub-metering services without a licence since February 20, 2024.

After considering the technical and financial capability of the applicant, the OEB finds that it is in the public interest to grant the application and issue the unit sub-metering licence to Enercan. The OEB notes the application was filed by the applicant 161 days after the expiration of the existing licence. Applicants are reminded of the importance to apply for renewal of any licence sufficiently prior to the expiry date to allow for processing of the application. The granting of this licence is without prejudice to any future compliance action regarding Enercan's operating without a licence.

### IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The application for a unit sub-metering licence is granted, on such conditions as are contained in the attached licence.
