**Application for approval of costs and the accounting
treatment of costs, associated with the Integrated
Resource Planning (IRP) Pilot Project**

PROCEDURAL ORDER NO. 6

November 5, 2024

The OEB has received submissions from Enbridge Gas, intervenors, and OEB staff. Having reviewed the submissions, the OEB is of the view that Enbridge Gas's response to the questions set out in Appendix A would help inform its decision on the application. Enbridge Gas will have until November 12, 2024, to provide its response to the OEB questions.

It is necessary to make provision for the following matters related to this proceeding. Further procedural orders may be issued by the OEB.

THE ONTARIO ENERGY BOARD ORDERS THAT:

1. Enbridge Gas shall file with the OEB complete written responses to the OEB questions and serve them on all intervenors by **November 12, 2024**.
