Further to the August 2, 2024 filing of the above-noted application and evidence, I can confirm that the request for an Order pursuant to s.8 of the *Municipal Franchises Act* cancelling and superseding those parts of the E.B.C. 59 Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (CPCN) held by Enbridge Gas related to the former Town of Grimsby and the former Township of North Grimsby and replacing them with a CPCN to construct works to supply natural gas in the current Town of Grimsby is in fact a request to cancel the remaining active components of the E.B.C. 59 CPCN.

The August 20, 2024 approval of a new CPCN for the Town of Lincoln (EB-2024-0168) and the associated cancellation of those parts of the E.B.C. 59 CPCN related to the former Village (Town) of Beamsville and the former Township of Clinton results in this current application effectively eliminating the need for the E.B.C. 59 CPCN since the parts of the E.B.C. 59 CPCN associated with the former Townships Caistor, Clinton, Gainsborough, and South Grimsby were superceded by the EB-2011-0238 CPCN issued on July 29, 2011 for the Township of West Lincoln.
