Reference: EB-2022-0012. Sun-Canadian Pipe Line E16M Creek Pipeline Replacement Project Final Monitoring Report

Sun-Canadian Pipe Line Company Limited is pleased to confirm that the construction and land restoration for the E16M Creek Pipeline Replacement Project have been completed in accordance with the Ontario Energy Board's Decision and Order (EB-2022-0012).

In compliance with Condition 6(b) of the OEB's Leave to Construct, we are submitting this letter as the final monitoring report, outlining the following:

- Certification that Sun-Canadian Pipe Line adhered to Condition 3, that Sun-Canadian Pipe Line obtained all approvals, permits, licenses, certificates, agreements and rights required to construct, operate and maintain the line replacement.
 - a. Sun-Canadian has completed all the easements required for this work and is only waiting on resolution of the Transfer, Release, and Abandonment (TREL) process by the Land Registry Office.
- ii. The rehabilitated lands have been restored to their pre-construction condition, with surface vegetation now fully re-established.
- iii. A drilling fluid spill ("frac-out") occurred during construction, which was promptly contained and remediated. No lasting impacts or visible signs of the incident remain.
- iv. The most recent inspection, conducted on August 28, 2024, confirms that the vegetation has successfully taken root and that the land has been returned to its pre-construction state.
- v. No complaints were received during the construction process. However, one neighbor raised concerns about reduced water levels in their well post-construction. This was first reported the week of August 15th, 2023. After a thorough investigation, including engagement of a third-party specialist, it was concluded that the construction activities did not contribute to this issue.
