**Re: EB-2024-0111 Enbridge Gas Inc. (EGI)
2024 Cost of Service Phase 2
Environmental Defence Motion**

This letter is made in accordance with Procedural Order No. 8 in the above noted proceeding. In that Order the Board states parties that wish to make submissions on the Environmental Defence Motion must notify the Board by November 15, 2024.

VECC may make a submission. However, as the Board points out in its Order the additional evidence Enbridge Gas has agreed to provide related to the motion are also due on November 15. As of this writing we have not had the opportunity to examine any new evidence on the subject put forward by the Applicant.

In general, however, we are not in support of what appears to be the most contentious, and perhaps only remaining issue, item (1) of the motion. Whether we will seek to make submissions specifically opposing the motion are unclear and will remain unclear until we have examined the new evidence of Enbridge. We therefore reserve on the question as to whether we will make a submission at the hearing on November 18, 2024. If we do it will not be in support of the motion.
