
We intend to operate solely as a broker or advisor arranging relationships for energy supply contracts between licensed retailers/suppliers and end use business customers.

We intend to operate solely as a broker or advisor arranging relationships for energy supply contracts between licensed retailers/suppliers and end use business customers. Retailers offer (1) variable/index pricing that is a defined markup on top of a defined wholesale index price; (2) fixed price products with some degree of variance or tolerance (aka load following); and (3) block products for a defined quantity of electricity consumed within a defined period of time (7x24, 5x8). Pricing for all products is set by the energy retailer/supplier and we as the broker/advisor put a small markup on their base price for our services.
