Further to the question submitted by Ontario Energy Board Staff related to the existing certificate of public convenience and necessity, Enbridge Gas provides the following response.

Staff Question-1

Reference: Application, page 1, para 4

Application, page 2, para 6 and 10

Application, Schedule C

Preamble:

Enbridge Gas states that it holds a certificate for the Township of Hamilton dated May 2, 1958. Enbridge Gas refers to the certificate as F.B.C. 210 in paragraph 4 and 10 of the application and F.B.C. 310 in paragraph 6 of the application.

The certificate number on the certificate for the Township of Hamilton provided in schedule C of the application is not legible.

Ouestion:

a) Please clarify what the certificate number is for Enbridge Gas's certificate for the Township of Hamilton.

Response:

a) The reference to F.B.C. 310 in paragraph 6 should be to F.B.C. 210. The current certificate of public convenience and necessity for the Township of Hamilton is F.B.C. 210. The handwritten proceeding number on the 1958 certificate is not clear, but the numbering corresponds to other certificates issued in 1958 (e.g., F.B.C. 197, F.B.C. 201, F.B.C. 202, F.B.C. 207, F.B.C. 216, F.B.C. 217).

The F.B.C. 310 certificate was issued in August 1959 for the Town of Kapuskasing.
