Re: Alectra Convergent Development LP - Section 80 Notices

In accordance with section 80 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998*, Alectra Convergent Development LP ("Alectra Convergent") is providing Notice of Intent to construct three electricity storage facilities in Ontario. Vaughan 3 Energy Storage 1 LP ("Vaughan 3 Energy Storage 1"), Vaughan 1E Energy Storage LP ("Vaughan 1E Energy Storage"), and Arlen Energy Storage 1 LP ("Arlen Energy Storage 1") are wholly owned indirect subsidiaries of Alectra Convergent, a newly formed Ontario limited partnership. Alectra Convergent is a joint venture partnership between Alectra Energy Services Inc. and Convergent Canada Acquisition Co. ULC which has been established for the purposes of owning and operating electricity storage facilities in Ontario.

The three subsidiaries of Alectra Convergent were selected as proponents of the Independent Electricity System Operator (IESO)'s Expedited Long-Term RFP (E-LT1-RFP), and will develop, own and operate storage facilities at the following locations:

- Arlen Energy Storage 1, a 20 MW lithium-ion battery storage facility located at 436 Clair Road West, Guelph, Ontario,
- Vaughan 1E Energy Storage 1, a 20 MW lithium-ion battery storage facility at 8118 Dufferin St. Concord, Ontario, and
- Vaughan 3 Energy Storage 1, a 40 MW lithium-ion battery storage facility at 6531 Rutherford Road in Vaughan, Ontario.

Each of the three storage facilities will provide peaking supply into the IESO Administered Markets for approximately four hours daily, and re-charge during off-peak hours.

Construction on the three storage facilities is expected to commence in Q1 2025. Commercial operation is expected to commence in Q4 2025.



As an affiliate of a licensed distributor or transmitter, Alectra-Convergent is obligated to give notice of intent to acquire/construct generation facilities. As a result, three separate section 80 notices are attached hereto. Each of the different facilities (Arlen Energy Storage 1, Vaughan 1E Energy Storage 1, and Vaughan 3 Energy Storage 1) will submit application to the OEB pursuant to subsections 57(c) and (d) of the Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998 (the "Act") for an electricity storage licence in due course.
