Re: ENWIN Utilities Ltd.

2025 IRM Rate Application, EB-2024-0019 Decision and Rate Order Comments

On December 12, 2024, the Ontario Energy Board ("OEB") issued a Decision and Rate Order for ENWIN Utilities Ltd.'s ("ENWIN") 2025 IRM Rate Application along with an updated 2025 IRM Rate Generator Model.

The OEB ordered that ENWIN review the Decision and accompanying Rate Order and provide written confirmation of completeness or inaccuracies by December 19, 2024.

ENWIN confirms it has reviewed these files and submits the following comments:

Decision and Rate Order Comments

• ENWIN has reviewed the Decision and Rate Order, including the Tariff of Rates and Charges set out in Schedule A, and confirms its accuracy and completeness.

2025 IRM Rate Generator Model Comments

- Tab 21. Bill Impacts
 - The Current Loss Factor and Proposed Loss Factor for the Large Use –
 Regular and Dedicated Transformer Station rate classes should be set to
 1.0045, rather than 1.0311 in cells I33, I34, J33, and J34.
 - The current OEB-approved Dedicated Transformer Station RTSR-Network rate should be \$5.3666 in cell F328 rather than \$0, and the RTSR-Connection rate in cell F329 should be \$0.9849 rather than \$6.3515.
 - The proposed Dedicated Transformer Station RTSR-Network rate should be \$6.0691 in cell I328 rather than \$0, and the RTSR-Connection rate in cell I329 should be \$1.0811 rather than \$7.1502.
 - The formulas calculating Total Bill on Non-RPP Avg. Price for the Residential Non-RPP (Retailer) rate class in cells H573 and K573 should be adjusted to include the Ontario Electricity Rebate value in cells H572 and K572.

- The formulas calculating Total Bill on Non-RPP Avg. Price for the General Service Less than 50 KW Non-RPP (Retailer) rate class in cells H629 and K629 should be adjusted to include the Ontario Electricity Rebate value in cells H628 and K628.
- ENWIN has provided an updated 2025 IRM Rate Generator Model encompassing the above updates to Tab 21 with its reply comments.
