Further to the question submitted by Ontario Energy Board Staff related to an existing certificate of public convenience and necessity, Enbridge Gas provides the following response.

Staff Question-1

Reference: Application, page 1, 5

Preamble:

In 1968, the Town of Aurora annexed parts of the former Township of Whitchurch. In 1971, the Town of Aurora annexed portions of the Township of King and additional portions of the Township of Whitchurch.

Enbridge Gas holds certificate F.B.C. 84 dated November 19, 1956 for the former Township of King.

Question:

a) Please discuss what municipalities are covered by F.B.C. 84 and whether the certificate can be cancelled entirely.

Response:

a) Certificate F.B.C. 84 was issued on November 19, 1956 for the Township of King only.
While there have been municipal boundary changes to the Township of King since the F.B.C.
84 certificate was issued, the Township of King still exists so the F.B.C. 84 certificate still needs to remain in place.

Enbridge Gas has applied to cancel and supersede the F.B.C. 84 certificate and replace it with a new certificate for the Township of King as part of the leave to construct application associated with the East Gwillimbury Community Expansion Project (EB-2023-0343).
