OVERVIEW

On May 23, 2024, Hydro One Networks Inc. filed an application, on behalf B2M Limited Partnership (B2M LP), under section 78 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998*, requesting approval of its 2025-2029 electricity transmission revenue requirement.

The OEB granted Association of Major Power Consumers in Ontario (AMPCO), Consumers Council of Canada (CCC), and School Energy Coalition (SEC) intervenor status and cost award eligibility.

On November 21, 2024, the OEB issued its Decision and Order in which it set out the process for cost claims.

The OEB received cost claims from AMPCO, CCC and SEC. No objections to the cost claims were received from B2M LP.

Findings

The OEB has reviewed the claims filed to ensure that they are compliant with the OEB's *Practice Direction on Cost Awards*.

The OEB finds that the cost claims are reasonable and shall be reimbursed by B2M LP.

THE ONTARIO ENERGY BOARD ORDERS THAT:

1. Pursuant to section 30 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998*, B2M LP shall immediately pay the following amounts to the intervenors for their costs:
