IN THE MATTER OF the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998*, S.O. 1998, c. 15, (Schedule B);

AND IN THE MATTER OF an application by Tillsonburg Hydro Inc. for an order approving just and reasonable rates and other charges for electricity distribution to be effective May 1, 2009.

PROCEDURAL ORDER No. 1

Tillsonburg Hydro Inc. (Tillsonburg Hydro or the Applicant) filed an application with the Ontario Energy Board, received on August 22, 2008, under section 78 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act*, *1998*, (the Act), seeking approval for changes to the rates that Tillsonburg Hydro charges for electricity distribution, to be effective May 1, 2009. The Board has assigned the application File Number EB-2008-0246.

The Board issued a Notice of Application and Hearing, which was published in the Tillsonburg Independent on October 08, 2008.

The Vulnerable Energy Consumers Coalition (VECC), the School Energy Coalition, the Energy Probe Research Foundation and the Association of Major Power Consumers in Ontario applied for intervenor status, together with the awarding of costs associated with their participation in the proceeding. No objections were received from the Applicant. The Board accepts the requests of these parties.

In addition, Ms. K. Englander, a resident of the Town of Tillsonburg sent an e-mail to the Board and to the applicant to express her concerns about the application and requesting intervenor status. The Board grants Ms. Englander intervenor status. To avoid duplication and to assist Ms. Englander in any representation she may choose to make in this matter, the Board encourages her to contact the representative from VECC (see Appendix B). Some or all of the issues that Ms. Englander wishes to bring forward in this case may be common or complementary to the issues that will be addressed by VECC. The Board notes that Ms. Englander has not asked to be eligible for an award

of costs. Should VECC not be in a position to advance Ms. Englander's interest and she pursues matters on her own, the Board, under section 7.01 of its Practice Direction on Cost Awards (available from the Board's web site at www.oeb.gov.on.ca), may award costs for reasonable out-of-pocket expenses such as postage, photocopying, transcript costs and travel and accommodation, provided that those expenses are directly related to the party's participation in the Board's process. The Board notes that Ms. Englander has provided the applicant with a copy of her e-mail. The Board will provide a copy of her e-mail to the other intervenors.

The Board recognizes that the costs of an intervention can be relatively significant for a smaller distributor. While the Board encourages active participation in the review of an application, intervenors should be mindful of the potential impact of these costs upon ratepayers, which the Board will take into consideration when it determines its cost awards. The Board will also take into account the quality and relevance of the intervention. In addition, the Board will consider any duplication of effort by intervenors in this proceeding. As a guide, the Board has attached a table (Appendix A) that summarizes the approved cost awards for those distributors that made cost of service applications for their 2008 rates.

A list of intervenors is attached as Appendix B to this order.

On October 24, 2008, the Applicant advised the Board that it will be filing an update to its evidence to reflect changing demand and energy consumption forecasts as a result of prevailing economic conditions, as well as changes to transmission rates and Regulated Price Plan prices. It anticipates the filing of the update in early November. Therefore, any further procedural matters regarding the review of this application have been deferred until the update has been filed. Depending on the magnitude of the update, a revised Notice of Application may be required.

Please be aware that this Procedural Order may be amended, and further procedural orders may be issued from time to time.

THE BOARD ORDERS THAT:

- 1. The Applicant provide a copy of its application to Ms. Englander.
- 2. The Applicant file the update to its evidence with the Board and identified intervenors as soon as practical. Until then, any further review of the application has been deferred.
- 3. Depending on the materiality of the update and the resulting impacts, the Board may issue a revised Notice of Application.

All filings to the Board must quote the file number, EB-2008-0246, be made through the Board's web portal at www.errr.oeb.gov.on.ca, and consist of two paper copies and one electronic copy in searchable / unrestricted PDF format. Filings must clearly state the sender's name, postal address and telephone number, fax number and e-mail address. If the web portal is not available you may email your document to the address below. Those who do not have internet access are required to submit all filings on a CD or diskette in PDF format, along with two paper copies. Those who do not have computer access are required to file 7 paper copies.
