Re: EB-2008-0220/Union Gas Limited ("Union")

We are counsel to the Consumers Council of Canada ("CCC"). We have been instructed by our client to request intervenor status in the application of Union for 2009 rates.

The CCC is a public-interest entity which represents the interests of, among others, residential consumers of natural gas in Union's franchise territory. The outcome of the application will have an impact on the rates which those consumers pay for Union's services.

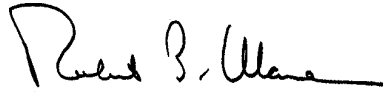
It may well be the case that Union's application can be disposed of on the basis of a written hearing only. However, it is premature to make that determination now, until the evidence has been examined through an interrogatory process. When the CCC has a fuller understanding of the evidence, it will make a submission as to whether an oral hearing is required.

The CCC intends to seek an order of costs, at the conclusion of the proceeding. The CCC represents the interests of residential consumers of natural gas. The CCC has participated in many of the applications of Union, seeking, among other relief, approval of its rates. In all of those proceedings, the CCC has been found eligible for an award of costs.
