INTERIM DECISION AND ORDER

Intellimeter Canada Inc. filed an application on December 20, 2007 with the Ontario Energy Board under section 60 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act*, 1998 (the "Act") for a smart sub-metering licence. The Board has assigned the application file number EB-2007-0964.

The applicant is currently engaged in smart sub-metering activities, as prescribed by Ontario Regulation 443/07—*Licensing Sub-Metering Activities* made under the Act. This regulation comes into force on December 31, 2007. Therefore, all persons currently engaged in smart sub-metering activities, as prescribed by Ontario Regulation 443/07, will need to be licensed.

Considering the time required to process an application in accordance with the Board's established practice and procedures, and considering the applicant's activities and the timing of the regulation, it has been found to be in the public interest to issue an interim order under sections 21(7) and 6(4) of the Act granting a short-term smart sub-metering licence to the applicant pending the final disposition of the matter.

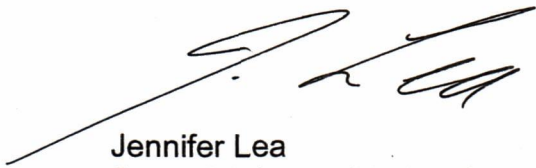
The applicant should note that no final decision on the application has been made and that the granting of this interim order is not an indication that a longer term licence will be granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

1. A smart sub-metering licence is granted on such conditions as are contained in the attached licence.
2. It is also a condition of this order that Intellimeter Canada Inc. expeditiously investigates and takes all appropriate and necessary steps to resolve any complaints from consumers regarding Intellimeter Canada Inc.'s smart sub-metering services.
3. The licence will be valid for a period of 4 months or until the Board makes a final decision on the smart sub-metering licence application, whichever is earlier.
