Your Electricity Wholesaler Licence EW-2007-0641 is due to expire on August 13, 2012.

If Cargill Energy Trading Canada, Inc. wishes to continue to participate in the Ontario Electricity market, you are invited to file an application to renew Cargill Energy Trading Canada, Inc.'s Electricity Wholesaler Licence. As you are aware, Cargill Energy Trading Canada, Inc. is not permitted to carry out activities described in section 57 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998* (the "Act") without a licence.

The standard time required to issue a licence is 90 days from receipt of a complete application. To assist the Board to renew Cargill Energy Trading Canada, Inc.'s licence in a timely manner prior to the expiry date, you are required to submit your application to the Board within 30 days of this e-mail. On receipt of the application, the Board will proceed to review the application for renewal in accordance with Part V of the Act. If we do not receive the application by the required date, the Board will be prepared to remove the name from the licensee records once the current licence is expired.
