**Re: Notice of Proposal Under Section 81 of the Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998
(the "OEB Act") as submitted by Kruger Energy Inc. ("KEI")
Board File Number EB-2007-0691**

We are counsel to KEI in the above-noted matter.

In its Procedural Order #2 dated March 27, 2008, the Ontario Energy Board (the "Board") ordered that a Technical Conference with regard to the above-noted matter take place on April 14, 2008 at 9:30 am (the "Technical Conference").

On April 2, 2008, KEI received the questions of Board Staff to be addressed at the Technical Conference. Upon a review of Board Staff's questions and given the level of detail and specificity, KEI does not believe that it will be in a position to address these issues as fully as would be beneficial to the Board in its consideration of KEI's Section 81 proposal by the date of April 14, 2008. Furthermore, KEI anticipates that it will require additional representatives to attend the Technical Conference to address the issues raised. These individuals are not available to attend on April 14, 2008 and are now viewed as essential to providing the Board with clarity on the issues Board Staff has raised in its questions that were sent earlier today.

For these reasons, KEI respectfully requests that the Technical Conference be adjourned until a further date to allow for the Technical Conference to yield the breadth and scope of answers that would be helpful for the Board in its consideration of KEI's proposal. KEI believes a date in early June would allow for these issues to be addressed in greater detail and for the availability of its required personnel.
