## Natural Gas Rates Have Changed

For Residential Customers who purchase their gas supply from **Enbridge Gas Distribution**

**Rate 1**

The Ontario Energy Board (“OEB”) has approved changes to Enbridge Gas Distribution’s rates effective **July 1, 2015**.

A typical residential homeowner will see an annual increase on their bill of about \$8 as a result of these changes. The increase is due to higher natural gas prices in North America and also reflects changes to Enbridge’s 2015 rates. The chart on the back provides a breakdown of the annualized changes. The total effect on your bill will depend on how much gas you use.

The Gas Supply and Transportation to Enbridge charges are based on North American market prices and established transportation prices. We pass these costs on to customers with no mark-up.

The Customer and Delivery charges recover fixed costs for infrastructure and customer service, as well as a regulated rate of return.

## Gas Supply Charge

The Gas Supply Charge has increased from 11.7285 cents per cubic metre (“¢/m<sup>3</sup>”) to 12.1794 ¢/m<sup>3</sup>. The Gas Supply component of the Cost Adjustment is currently a charge of 2.5730 ¢/m<sup>3</sup>. This charge, combined with the Gas Supply Charge, results in a new total effective Gas Supply rate of 14.7524 ¢/m<sup>3</sup>.

## Transportation to Enbridge

The Transportation charge has decreased by approximately \$3 per year for a typical customer due to lower costs for transporting natural gas to Ontario.

## Delivery to You

The Delivery charge has increased by approximately \$8 per year for a typical customer due to higher delivery related costs and changes to Enbridge’s 2015 rates.

## Cost Adjustment

The total Cost Adjustment charge is 4.5276 ¢/m<sup>3</sup>, effective until June 30, 2016. Please see the chart on the reverse for the breakdown by component.

## Site Restoration Clearance

The Site Restoration Clearance refund remains at 1.4058 ¢/m<sup>3</sup>. It reflects changes in an estimate of ongoing and future site restoration costs. Site restoration costs are incurred when gas distribution pipelines are replaced or retired over the life of the gas distribution system.

## Rate Adjustment

The OEB has also approved a Rate Adjustment to reflect the difference between 2015 interim rates and final approved rates for the period of January 1, 2015 to June 30, 2015. For a typical residential customer, this adjustment will be a charge of about \$9 (\$3 per month) that will be included in the ‘Delivery to You’ charge on the July, August and September bills.

## Les tarifs du gaz naturel ont changé

La Commission de l'énergie de l'Ontario (CEO) a approuvé des changements aux tarifs facturés par Enbridge Gas Distribution à compter du **1<sup>er</sup> juillet 2015**.

Un client résidentiel moyen constatera une augmentation annuelle de sa facture d'environ 8 \$ suite à ces changements. La hausse reflète les prix du gaz naturel plus élevés en Amérique du Nord et les changements aux tarifs de Enbridge en 2015. Le tableau au verso indique la variation annualisée des tarifs. L'incidence sur votre facture dépend de la quantité de gaz que vous consommez.

Les frais de fourniture de gaz et de transport vers Enbridge sont calculés en fonction des prix sur le marché nord-américain et des prix fixés pour le transport. Nous passons ces coûts aux abonnés sans aucune majoration.

Les frais d'abonnés et de livraison chez vous permettent de récupérer les coûts fixes d'infrastructure et du service aux abonnés ainsi que ceux du taux de rendement réglementé.

## Frais de fourniture de gaz

Les frais de fourniture de gaz sont passés de 11,7285 cents le mètre cube ( $\text{¢/m}^3$ ) à 12,1794  $\text{¢/m}^3$ . Les frais d'ajustement liés à l'approvisionnement en gaz s'élèvent actuellement à 2,5730  $\text{¢/m}^3$ . Ces frais, combinés avec les frais d'approvisionnement de gaz, se traduisent par un nouveau tarif total d'approvisionnement de gaz en vigueur de 14,7524  $\text{¢/m}^3$ .

## Transport vers Enbridge

Les frais de transport ont diminué d'environ 3 \$ par an pour un abonné moyen en raison de la baisse des coûts liés au transport de gaz naturel vers l'Ontario.

## Livraison chez vous

Les frais de livraison pour un abonné moyen ont augmenté d'environ 8 \$ par an en raison de la hausse des coûts de livraison et des changements aux tarifs de Enbridge en 2015.

## Ajustement des coûts

Les coûts totaux d'ajustement sont de 4,5276  $\text{¢/m}^3$ , en vigueur jusqu'au 30 juin 2016. Veuillez consulter le tableau au verso pour voir la ventilation par élément.

## Restauration de sites

Le remboursement concernant la décharge de restauration demeure à 1,4058  $\text{¢/m}^3$ . Cela correspond aux changements d'estimation des coûts pour la restauration de sites en cours et à venir. Les coûts de restauration de sites concernent le remplacement ou la suppression des gazoducs au cours de l'exploitation du réseau de distribution de gaz.

## Ajustement tarifaire

La CEO a également approuvé un ajustement tarifaire pour refléter l'écart entre les tarifs provisoires de 2015 et les tarifs finaux approuvés pour la période allant du 1<sup>er</sup> janvier 2015 au 30 juin 2015. Pour un abonné résidentiel type, cet ajustement représentera des frais d'environ 9 \$ (3 \$ par mois) qui seront inclus dans la rubrique « Livraison chez vous » sur les factures de juillet, août et septembre.

## Transportation to Enbridge

### **If your transportation service is provided by Enbridge**

Your ‘Transportation to Enbridge’ charge will appear in the top Enbridge portion of your Enbridge Gas Distribution charges.

This Transportation charge has decreased by approximately \$3 per year for a typical customer due to lower costs for transporting natural gas to Ontario.

### **If your transportation service is provided by your marketer**

Your ‘Transportation to Enbridge’ charge will appear with your Marketer charges on your bill. The rate you pay for transportation is based on the terms of your gas marketer agreement.

## Delivery to You

The Delivery charge has increased by approximately \$8 per year for a typical customer due to higher delivery related costs and changes to Enbridge’s 2015 rates.

## Cost Adjustment

The current cost adjustment includes a charge of 1.7898 ¢/m<sup>3</sup> for Delivery and a charge of 0.1648 ¢/m<sup>3</sup> for Transportation. This cost adjustment is in effect until June 30, 2016.

The Ontario Energy Board (“OEB”) has approved changes to Enbridge Gas Distribution’s rates effective **July 1, 2015.**

A typical commercial and industrial heating customer will see an annual increase on their bill of about 1% as a result of these changes. The increase is due to higher natural gas prices in North America and also reflects changes to Enbridge’s 2015 rates. The chart on the back provides a breakdown of the annualized changes. The total effect on your bill will depend on how much gas you use.

The Gas Supply and Transportation to Enbridge charges are based on North American market prices and established transportation prices. We pass these costs on to customers with no mark-up.

The Customer and Delivery charges recover fixed costs for infrastructure and customer service, as well as a regulated rate of return.

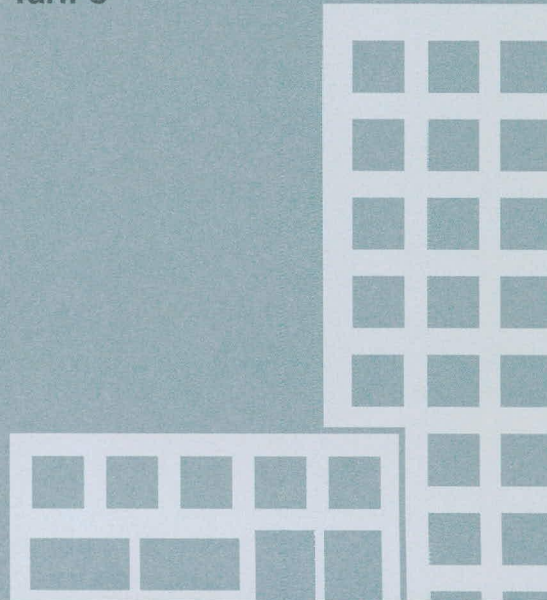
