I am a resident of Guelph. I am asking that the Ontario Energy Board reject Enbridge's undemocratic request to force the City of Guelph to enter into an agreement that would lock us into providing no-fee access to our public lands for 20 years. This is an opaque, unfair, inappropriate and climate-harming fossil fuel subsidy. Our City Council and Member of Provincial Parliament both oppose this. The Ontario Energy Board should not force this on Guelph against our will.

I also ask that eMERGE Guelph be allowed to participate in a hearing on this issue for appropriate transparency. It is vitally important that civil society be allowed to participate, including a group like eMERGE, which represents the interests of Guelph residents like me and environmental interests that are to the benefit of all Ontarians.
