Re: EB-2024-0319 - HYDRO ONE NETWORKS INC. - WAASIGAN - EXPROPRIATION

We are the landowners of the parcels of land known as [REDACTED] by Hydro One Networks Inc. (Hydro One) in their application documents. We are writing to you with concerns regarding Hydro One's submission to you on January 30, 2025 pertaining to their Service of Notice Proof of Delivery.

We believe it is incumbent upon the OEB, when deciding an issue as serious as the potential expropriation of a person's private property, to insure the information they are provided by the applicant is truthful and accurate.

First, although there are no other persons with a registered interest in our properties, in this submission Hydro One has listed easement interest for someone on both properties. These did not appear in the original filings. Because of the redactions on the public record, we have no way of knowing who Hydro One has determined to have an interest in our land. Hydro One proceeded to serve notice on these persons of the expropriation application. Our concern is they delivered private confidential documents to parties with no right to be privy to this information. Please refer to [REDACTED] of their submission on January 30, 2025, page 1 of the Proof of Delivery Index. We refer you to [REDACTED]. Further in the Proof of Delivery document there are pictures of a home on [REDACTED].

[REDACTED] that is not ours. Not only has our privacy been violated, but the other persons has as well. Please clarify and advise who the parties are and the details of this alleged easement.

Second, [REDACTED] an affidavit containing false statements has been entered as evidence. Mr. Martin Webster, a contractor for Infrastructure Development Alliance Inc., which is a contractor for Hydro One Networks Inc. attests in his affidavit at [REDACTED] that he knew who he was having a conversation with. Mr. Webster was encountered on our driveway leaving our property on January 24, 2025. I was with another person at the time in my vehicle. He asked if I was Joanne Drew and I replied yes. He never inquired who the other person was in the entire conversation, but swears in his affidavit he knew who he was speaking with and confirmed that both of these people received packages.
