Re: Enbridge Gas Inc. (Enbridge Gas, or the Company) EB-2024-0078 – Review Motion/ EB-2022-0200 – 2024 Rates Application Enbridge Gas Submissions on Cost Claims

Pursuant to the OEB's Decision and Order dated April 15, 2025, Enbridge Gas has reviewed the cost claims received from Canadian Manufacturers & Exporters (CME), Industrial Gas Users Association (IGUA), Ontario Greenhouse Vegetable Growers (OGVG), Pollution Probe, School Energy Coalition (SEC), Three Fires Group (TFG), and Vulnerable Energy Consumers' Coalition (VECC).

There was considerable variation in the amount of hours spent by intervenors, from a low of 9 hours to a high of just over 40 hours.

Enbridge Gas notes that while it had the third highest cost claim, TFG made submissions only on one of the issues at the threshold stage and did not make a submission on the merits.
