OVERVIEW

Enbridge Gas Inc. (Enbridge Gas) filed an application with the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) under section 36 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act*, *1998* seeking approval to clear 2022 deferral and variance account balances in three Demand Side Management deferral and variance accounts, related to the delivery of natural gas conservation and energy efficiency programs.

The OEB approved School Energy Coalition's (SEC) request for intervenor status and cost eligibility.

On March 11, 2025 the OEB issued its Decision and Order setting out, among other things, the process for addressing cost awards.

SEC filed its cost claim on April 14, 2025. Enbridge Gas noted in its letter dated April 16, 2025 that it had no objections to SEC's cost claim.

Findings

The OEB has reviewed SEC's cost claim to ensure that it is compliant with the OEB's *Practice Direction on Cost Awards* and finds that the cost claim of SEC is reasonable and shall be reimbursed by Enbridge Gas.

THE ONTARIO ENERGY BOARD ORDERS THAT:

Pursuant to section 30 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998*, Enbridge Gas shall promptly pay \$1,715.34 to SEC for their costs.
