



# NOTICE OF A RATE HEARING

Burlington Hydro Inc. has applied to change its electricity distribution rates effective January 1, 2026

If the application is approved as filed, a typical residential customer and a typical general service customer of Burlington Hydro Inc. would see the following increase:

1	Residential (750 kWh)	\$9.84 per month
1	General Service less than 50kW (2,000 kWh)	\$17.81 per month

Other customers, including businesses, will also be affected.

Bur lington Hydro Inc. has also applied for approval of a proposed Advanced Capital Module for the replacement of its existing super visory control and data acquisition system and implementation of an advanced distribution management system and to dispose of certain deferral and variance account balances.

It is important to review the application carefully to determine whether you may be affected by the proposed changes.

#### YOU SHOULD KNOW

There are three types of OEB hearings: oral, electronic and written. The applicant has applied for, and the OEB plans to proceed with, a written hearing. If you think a different hearing type is needed, you can write to us to explain why.

During this hearing, we will hear questions and arguments from participants about this case. We will also hear questions and arguments from participants that have registered as Intervenors. After the hearing, we will decide whether to approve the application.
