Issues:

CCMBC members are commercial and small industrial customers of the applicant. The rates they pay will be impacted by the outcome of this proceeding. CCMBC is interested in the following parts of the application: opening rate base, rate base additions, asset management plan including investments in reliability improvements, DER connections, OM&A costs, load forecast and how it deals with electrification and EV charging, cost allocation and rate design for commercial and small industrial customers and disposition of deferral and variance accounts.
