Pursuant to the direction in Procedural Order No. 2, any intervenor wishing to file evidence in Phase 3 must submit a request to the OEB by May 30, 2025 in accordance with Rule 13 of the OEB's Rules of Practice and Procedure.

Accordingly, TCPL requests leave from the OEB to file evidence in this proceeding. As an EGI customer contracting for a significant amount of transportation capacity on the Dawn Parkway

System, any evidence submitted by TCPL will be relevant to EGI's proposed cost allocation, rate design, or service harmonization proposals that impact ex-franchise services. These issues are addressed in the Phase 3 approved Issues List, notably Issue 1 - Part B, Issue 2, Issue 3 - Part C, and Issue 5. TCPL seeks to obtain leave to submit evidence in the event that it determines evidence is required to ensure that its existing service rights, flexibility features, and terms and conditions of service under the existing M12, C1, and Rate 332 rate classes are maintained under the proposal to harmonize these rate classes into the new E70 rate class.

In the event that TCPL submits evidence, it will be presented by the company rather than a third-party expert. TCPL will not seek an award of costs for its participation in this proceeding.
